Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially employing 4 people. Sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Within 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty workers and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is among the top international makers in the material handling business.

Manufacture and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of new business opportunities. During the last sixty years, the material handling industry has developed into a very sophisticated field and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this growth. Cascade at present continues to develop as the premier provider of lift truck accessories and numerous related items. The business feels certain in their ability to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the international market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to fabricate, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was built in 1956, in order to accommodate all of the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current head office. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry when the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities within the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are manufactured worldwide thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in blades.
